Cask Ales

Sambrook's Session Hop Forward Pale Ale

Battersea, Greater London • Pale Ale - English • 3.4% ABV

Untappd Rating:

A light hoppy pale ale with a well-rounded bitterness and sweet tropical and pink grapefruit finish.

Southwark LPA – London Pale Ale

Southwark, London • Pale Ale - English • 4% ABV

Untappd Rating:

Traditional English Ale with Kentish Hops.

Twickenham Fine Ales Naked Ladies

Twickenham, London • Golden Ale • 4.4% ABV

Untappd Rating:

Outstanding, glorious, hoppy golden ale using Herkules, Celeia and Chinook hops for full-flavoured satisfaction. Inspired by the statues of water nymphs in York House gardens in Twickenham, known locally as the "Naked Ladies". Silver – Champion Beer of Britain 2014 London & SE Golden Ale category and Won the Best Bitters category at Reading Beer Festival 2008 and 2011.

Purity Brewing Co. (England) Pure Gold

Alcester, Warwickshire • Golden Ale • 3.8% ABV

Untappd Rating:

Cask ABV: 3.8%, Bottle ABV: 4.3%. A refreshing Golden Ale made with English Maris Otter & Cara Gold malts plus Northern Brewer, Fuggles, Hereford Golding and Styrian Golding hops. Creating an easy drinking beer with a lovely dry and bitter finish.

Sharp's Cornish Coaster

Rock, Cornwall • Golden Ale • 3.6% ABV

Untappd Rating:

Originally brewed for the brewery's launch in 1994, Coaster was named after a style of boat which on occasion can be seen plying its trade near our home at Rock on Cornwall's rugged North Atlantic coast. Brewed to 3.6% ABV but with a generous measure of flavour and light golden hue, Cornish Coaster is both moreish and refreshing and the perfect beer to quench the thirst on a hot summers day.

Sharp's Doom Bar

Rock, Cornwall • English Bitter • 4% ABV

Untappd Rating:

Doom Bar is inspired by its namesake, the treacherous sandbank at the mouth of the Camel Estuary near Sharps' home at Rock. Accomplished and precise, Doom Bar is the epitome of consistency, balance and moreish appeal and is now the UK's no.1 selling cask beer. An enticing aroma of resinous hop, sweet malt and delicate roasted notes. The mouth feel is a balanced, complex blend of succulent dried fruit, lightly roasted malt and a subtle yet assertive bitterness. The finish is dry and refreshing. ABV: 4.0% (CASK), 4.3% (BOTTLE)

Westons Cider Rosie's Pig Cloudy Cider

Ledbury, Herefordshire • Cider - Dry • 4.8% ABV

Dry cloudy cider

Hambleton Ales GFA

Melmerby • Gluten-Free • 4.8% ABV

Untappd Rating: 

A tawny ale with aromas of Cascade, Liberty and Challenger hops and specially prepared dark sugars providing full bodied initial sweetness giving way to pronounced fruit and hop character with a strong citrus finish. Voted Europe's Best Gluten-free Specialty Beer 2015.

Abbaye de Leffe Leffe Blonde / Blond

Dinant, Namur • Blonde Ale - Belgian Blonde • 6.6% ABV

Untappd Rating: 

In the fifties, an extraordinary meeting took place that all beer enthusiasts should raise their glass of Leffe to. The abbey's Father Abbot Nys became acquainted with Albert Lootvoet, a master brewer. Passionate about the future of the brewery, Father Nys was upset to have to witness how, since the unpleasant stay of the French revolutionaries, the brewery had slowly fallen into decline and had eventually had to close its doors in 1809. Such a magnificent place could not be forgotten, he believed, and he vowed to bring the...

Adnams Jack Brand Mosaic Pale Ale

Southwold, Suffolk • Pale Ale - English • 4.1% ABV

Untappd Rating: 

The Mosaic hop variety was released in 2012 after a successful crossing of two hop varieties called Simcoe and Nugget which captured the best of these varieties to provide clean bitterness and outstanding flavours and aromas. Mosaic hops are similar to Citra, but has an even more intense flavour. Fergus and the team added the Mosaic hops at three stages during the boil, and once again during fermentation. This has imparted bold hop characters of peach, mango, lemon and pine. All these lovely flavours are complemented by pale ale malt, lager...

John Smith's Newcastle Brown Ale

Tadcaster, North Yorkshire • Brown Ale - English • 4.7% ABV

Untappd Rating: 

Newcastle Brown Ale is a brand of beer produced by Heineken International. The beer was introduced in 1927 in Newcastle upon Tyne, England, by Newcastle Breweries, which became Scottish & Newcastle in 1960. In 2005, brewing was moved out of Newcastle for the first time to the other side of the River Tyne, to Dunston in Gateshead. In 2009, it was announced that production would move to Tadcaster North Yorkshire.

Goose Island Beer Honkers Ale

Chicago, IL • English Bitter • 4.3% ABV

Untappd Rating: 

Inspired by visits to English country pubs, Honker's Ale combines a fruity hop aroma with a rich malt middle to create a perfectly balanced beer. Immensely drinkable, Honker's Ale is not only the beer you can trust but one you'll look forward to time and again.

Lagunitas IPA

Petaluma, CA • IPA - American • 6.2% ABV

Untappd Rating: 

This is our unique version of an ancient style. A style as old as the ocean trade routes of the last centuries Great Ships. Not as old as the equator they had to cross twice enroute. Lagunitas IPA was our first seasonal way back in 1995. The recipe was formulated with malt and hops working together to balance it all out on your 'buds so you can knock back more than one without wearing yourself out. Big on the aroma with a hoppy-sweet finish that'll leave you wantin' another sip.

Goose Island Beer Goose IPA

Chicago, IL • IPA - English • 5.9% ABV

Our India Pale Ale recalls a time when ales shipped from England to India were highly hopped to preserve their distinct taste during the long journey. The result is a hop lover's dream with a fruity aroma, set off by a dry malt middle, and long hop finish.
